


# FROG SPLASH

**GRADES PK+** 

### **MATERIALS**

- Frog Splash game boards
- Frog toys
- Spinners





Allow children to explore the game pieces, spinners, and game boards.



Choose a game board, spinner, and have each player choose a frog as their game piece. Choose a starting place and an ending place (land or the log). Take turns spinning to see how many leaps to make. Keep going until the frogs reach the end.



Choose a different board and play again. Have fun leaping, swimming, spinning, and counting!

### **KEY CONCEPTS**

### **Counting & Cardinality**

Child knows number names and the count sequence. Child recognizes the number of objects in a small set. Child compares numbers.

# Geometry & Spatial Sense

Child explores the positions of objects in space.

## Symbolic Representation & Play

Child uses objects or symbols to represent something else.

### **QUESTIONS TO ASK**

- What do you want to know about frogs?
- How many dots/fingers did the arrow land on?
- What other ways can we play this game?
- How many more lily pads until the frog reaches the pond?

#### **THINGS TO NOTICE**

- Child's creativity with the game pieces.
- Child's recognition of patterns on the spinners.
- How the child counts their leaps. Does the child match each move with a count?
  On which lily pad does the child say "one"?
- How the child interacts with the different boards.
